

# CHANGE NOTIFICATION – EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2021



## Critical Illness (CI) Insurer Change and Enhancement

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Your Chambers Plan may include Critical Illness benefits, which were previously underwritten by Wawanesa Life.

This benefit is now (**as of April 1, 2021**) provided by Sutton Special Risk, underwritten by Lloyd's.

Enhancements to the program include coverage for additional conditions, Cancer Recurrence, Early Stage Diagnosis, and Multiple Events, as well as access to the Care Navigator Benefit. Further, the benefit will terminate on the Plan anniversary date (i.e., April 1) following a Plan member's 70th birthday rather than following their 65th birthday. Under options CI2 and CI4, \$5,000 of coverage will be provided per eligible dependent child at no additional cost.

## Services Performed by a Relative

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The Extended Health *Limitations and Exclusions* section of the Chambers Plan Master Contracts contains the following provision:

*No reimbursement will be made under this Benefit for the following:*

*g) services or treatment performed by any Physician, Dentist or paramedical practitioner listed under Eligible Expenses who is related by blood or connected by marriage to either the Employee or any of his Dependents or normally resides with the Employee or any of his Dependents;*

**As of April 1, 2021**, this provision will be removed from all Chambers Plan Master Contracts.
